

New Jersey Enhanced Warranty Design Protocol

All Enhanced warranty systems in NJ must be designed by an Enhanced Warranty Certified Designer, maintained by an Enhanced Warranty Certified O&M Provider, and installed by an Enhanced Warranty Certified Installer. Infiltrator can provide an updated list of Enhanced Warranty parties.

- All Enhanced Designers must be properly licensed in NJ
- The Enhanced Warranty only applies to conventional systems (gravity and pump systems)
- All septic tanks shall be Infiltrator tanks (IM series)
- All pump tanks shall be Infiltrator tanks (IM series)
- All septic tanks must be 2-compartment tanks AND have an effluent filter (Minimum 6" Polylock PL250)
- All tanks must have risers installed up to at least grade level on the outlet end (inlet risers may also be required by designer or on 2-compartment tanks) and all riser connections must be watertight with a positive drainage slope to divert surface water away from the tank
- All pipe used on the system shall be Schedule 40 PVC (no Corrugated pipe allowed)
- All systems must have a water meter installed or access to community water records (in the case of wells, the water meter shall be installed near the well head in separate enclosure)
- Certified Installers must have their 1st installation signed off from an IWT representative who must be present during the installation
- Each row of chambers must have observation ports brought to grade for access during yearly O&M inspections

- All d-boxes must be installed with grade level access and installed level with speed levelers to ensure equal distribution
- When using chambers on pump systems all chambers must have a High Flow splash plate or approved equivalent installed on the inlet end with a 90 degree elbow faced down on the splash plate (see our install instruction for IWT approved options)
- All trenches or beds must be installed as level as possible (with a variance of up to 2" of fall per 100 foot of trench)
- No system shall be installed during wet conditions
- All pump systems shall be time-dosed
- No water conditioners feeding into the septic system
- No irrigation lines allowed over the drainfield or tank
- Certified installers must initial and check off the Infiltrator Enhanced Warranty Installation checklist
- The system must be assigned an Enhanced Warranty Certified O&M provider with a signed O&M agreement.
- Infiltrator installation instructions shall be followed for all IWT products used at all times
- Each row of chambers shall be connected on the ends at the bottom of the endcap with 4" Schedule 40 pipe
- Certified Installers must renew their certification every 4 years
